SAFETY OVER GLASSES



Safety over glasses are designed to fit over your existing glasses and spread the impact over a larger area. They can also be worn by those that do not have glasses as their also known as visitor glasses so if someone comes into your workshop you can give them a loan of these and feel happier that you are doing the right thing, there would be nothing worse than a mate helping you and finishing up hurting themselves.

SAFETY VISORS



Safety visors are another piece of equipment you should have in your workshops as they give you more face protection. They are fully adjustable across the top and around the back of your head. You have the brow guard and a poly carbonate visor which can withstand fairly severe impacts. The visor is replicable when it gets

too scratched to see through clearly.

SAFETY

Just recently one of our friends had an accident in his workshop. He was wearing glasses but they still got damaged. It was not the glass that caused the problem but the frame that got bent and twisted and cut into his face and luckily stopped there. If the impact had been any harder he could have lost his eye. Because of this the club he belongs to has made it mandatory that everyone wears proper safety glasses or a face shield in the workshop.

He now wears the safety over glasses which cover his prescription glasses. This does 2 things, spreads the impact to the brow and cheek and saves his prescription glasses.

Everyone when they enter a workshop whether it is at home or a friends place or the local club should get into the habit of putting their safety gear on, it only takes a moment to do this but it takes less time for some damage to happen. In terry's case he was lucky and has another laugh line under his eye but it could have been a lot worse.

Make safety a priority in any workshop you enter.

HEGNER CLAMPS & KEY



We are now able to supply the Hegner clamps and key for those wanting replacement parts or want to upgrade their Trupro or WMS scrollsaw. There is the standard blade clamp which has the square head screw which can be used on both the top & bottom clamps. 22-020 \$17.95ea

There is the Upper blade clamp with the knurled knob which a lot of scrollers prefer as it makes taking of and replacing the blade quicker and easier than the key version. 22-003 \$48.35

The square key has been upgraded to make it easier to use as it is longer than the original. 22-021 \$16.35

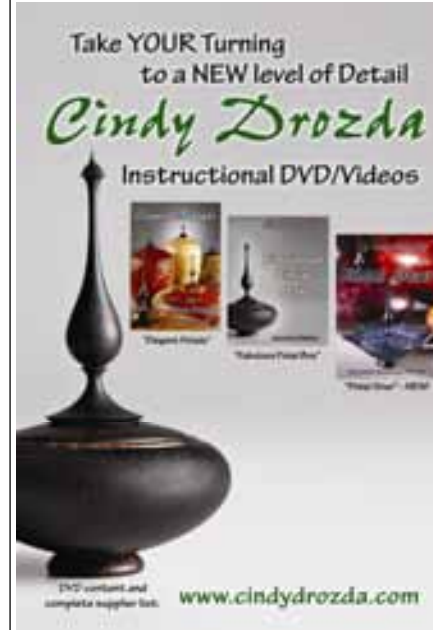

WOODCUT PRO-FORME FLEXI



A new addition to the woodcut range is the Pro-Forme Flexi which is a smaller version of their hollowing tools. It has a 1/2" shaft with 2 flexible heads and allows you to do small to medium sized hollow forms. You are able to articulate a long way to do undercut lips if required. The tool is complete with a foam gripped handle and included is a 10mm collet so you can use 10mm or 1/2" gouges in the handle.
